Release of Liability for EAPL Volunteers Fosters/Dog Walkers/Transporters/Pet Sitters, etc.

The undersigned assumes all risk of injury to himself/herself (and if applicable to any volunteer minor child of the undersigned) which may be incurred as a result of working with, or contact with, or caring for any or all animals (dogs and/or cats) in the Evergreen Animal Protective League (EAPL). Volunteer tasks may include dog walking, transport, and pet sitting, and any other tasks deemed necessary to care for EAPL animals.

You are working with an animal that we do not know the complete history of. They are shelter animals; usually they are strays/owner surrenders who are being saved from euthanization. We have not met the animals prior to them being transferred to EAPL. EAPL attempts to screen and restrain animals appropriately, but volunteers should be aware that some animals, when introduced to new situations or persons, can behave unpredictably and may, on occasion, become aggressive out of fear or stress.

In consideration for the undersigned (and, if applicable, for any volunteer minor child of the undersigned) being able to work with and care for EAPL animals during walks, exercising, vet visits, home visits for adoption, transportation, etc. the undersigned releases, and agrees to hold harmless EAPL, and the officers, directors, employees, volunteers, agents, representatives and members of EAPL from any and all liabilities, actions, causes of action, claims, damages, costs or losses (i.e. resulting from scratches, bites, pet fights, or any material damage) incurred by the undersigned or any minor child of the undersigned, which in any way arise while the undersigned or any minor child has an EAPL animal in their temporary care.

Further, in consideration of being able to work with an EAPL animal, the undersigned understands that EAPL does not carry workmen's compensation coverage for any of our volunteers and waives any right to receive workmen's compensation benefits and releases, and agrees to hold and save EAPL harmless from liability or claim by the undersigned or minor child of the undersigned with respect to workmen's compensation benefits.

Also, even though EAPL animals have been examined by a veterinarian, they may still have an infection or unknown parasites that can be passed onto humans, which is not manifesting symptoms at the time of the contact. We advise you to take precautions by frequently washing your hands while performing your duties, handling the animals and returning the animal to the foster home.
